## Staying Safe on Campus

Berkeley is one of the most densely populated urban areas in the United States, and as such it is important to remember that our neighborhood will never be completely safe. Recent events that have taken place in our community have made this fact especially evident, and IFC and PHC have been working closely together to find ways to address this important issue. Through joint meetings between our executive boards, as well as meetings with chapter presidents from both councils, we have worked to develop easy to implement safety strategies. Your chapter should have received a laminated IFC recommended safety guidelines sheet that outlines these strategies; it should be posted in a visible place.

## CalGreeks at WRGA

Besides following your own chapter's risk management guidelines, and those outlined in the Greek Social Code, here are some other easy to implement strategies that you and your chapter can follow in order to increase the safety of our community:

- Make sure there is only one entry point to your house and that all other possible entryways are locked (doors, windows, etc.)
- Offer to walk guests home from your chapter house whether after an event or otherwise.
- Turn on any exterior lighting on your chapter house in order to illuminate the streets since many streets are not adequately illuminated.
- Call the police in the event of any potentially dangerous situation, or if you see something suspicious—their job is to help keep our community safe!
