## Leadership Development

Leadership is one of the four core values of our Greek community at Cal and it is something many of us will experience at some point, typically in the form of an officer position within our chapters. The Center for Student Leadership (CSL) offers a variety of leadership development seminars, workshops, and more. **Workshops:** There are a number of workshops that your chapter can request, to be held either at your chapter or elsewhere. One of the more exciting opportunities is the ropes course that is available through Cal Adventures. Located in Strawberry Canyon it's a great way to bring chapter officers together in a unique environment. As a member of an IFC chapter, you are most likely aware that your chapter pays dues to IFC each semester. What you may not know is how your chapter's dues are spent by the executive council. This semester alone, IFC has planned to subsidize several large-scale programming events that allow members of the Greek community to network at fun events for affordable prices. Some of these events include the February Warrior's Night, and will likely also include a trip to a San Francisco Giants game. In addition to events, IFC

**Conferences:** In addition to workshops, your chapter has the opportunity to attend local and national conferences. On campus, you can attend the Leadership Symposium, a day-long spring semester event where you can hear speakers and network with other student leaders. Further away are the Western Region Greek Association conference and the Undergraduate Interfraternity Institute, both of which provide you with the opportunity to network with Greeks from campuses across the country.

**Four Year Development Program:** Finally there is the CSL's long term leadership development program, meant to provide leadership development as soon as a member becomes initiated. Starting with new member camp and progressing through officer workshops and career development, this process ensures that leadership development is not simply a one-time event, but a continuous learning experience that occurs throughout your time here at Cal.
