IFC Semester in Review

As finals season approaches, it marks a good time for us not just as council officers, but as an entire IFC community to reflect on our successes throughout this past semester, as well as areas for improvement.

Greek Programming: This semester IFC in cooperation with PHC held two sports nights where Greeks could attend either a Warrior's game or a Giant's game for only \$20. The low cost of the combined bus and ticket brought out more than 500 PHC/IFC members for these inter-council events.



CalGreeks.com: A completely redesigned Calgreeks.com website was launched this semester with the intent of not only projecting



a more professional image of our community, but also serving as an important resource for chapters as they plan social events, submit information to the university, and work to attract potential recruits.

Social Code: Although it has taken several semesters, we have finally arrived at a point where we can pass the revised social code. Reflecting

changes in state/local laws, passing the social code serves to show that IFC chapters take risk management seriously.

Cal Day: With more than one hundred IFC/PHC members participating in the pre-Cal Day cleanup and numerous chapters tabling on Sproul, CalGreeks and IFC had a positive impact of our local community and hopefully were successful in attracting potential recruits.

Delegate Committees: We intend to continue developing the committees we established as a way for delegates to become directly involved with IFC projects, and hope that delegates will continue to provide their input on these committees.
