## GREEN CHAPTER SPOTLIGHT!

### March - April 2011



In an attempt to make our Panhellenic community more environmentally aware, sustainability chairs have been busy implementing educational and action projects within their chapters. Great work to the following chapters!

Alpha Chi Omega – Hosted a month-long sustainable bathroom competition, rewarding members for turning the lights off, properly sorting trash/recycling/compost, and not leaving empty toilet paper rolls

Alpha Delta Pi – Made detailed educational posters to put up in the hallway waste stations outlining what should be recycled, composted, and thrown out

Alpha Omicron Pi - Created AOII reusable nalgene water bottles

Alpha Phi – Organizing a chapter educational event about safe, toxic-free cosmetic products

PLUS implemented **Vegetarian Thursdays!** Alpha Phi has been extremely successful in this initiative of reducing meat intake by one day a week. It's a great way to promote sustainability plus save money on food.

Chi Omega – Hosting a sustainability-themed sisterhood event which will show an environmental documentary and provide snacks from the Berkeley Student Food Collective

Gamma Phi Beta – Started a plastic bag collection program to recycle bags back to grocery stores

Kappa Kappa Gamma – Designing a “Kappa Goes Green” line including organic cotton sweats and reusable water bottles
