Tutoring Opportunity for Greek Students

There is an after school tutoring program developed and instituted by Stiles Hall, a local volunteer and community service organization here in Berkeley. Tutors would meet with their paired student once a week for an hour for the majority of the semester, last year it was Wednesdays from 4 to 5pm, to go over academic work the child may have. If the student does not have any school material to go over, this time can be spent playing outside and/or partaking in other activities.
